

Did you know that AAIR provides state-of-the-art fiber-optic rhinolaryngoscopy to help be better detectives for patients with nasal and sinus problems? Our physicians use a fiber-optic scope, smaller than a q-tip, to examine the upper airways with attention to nasal and inner ear passages, sinus openings, and the voice box. Patients can be assessed for upper airway injury, sinus infections, nasal polyps, and silent laryngopharyngeal reflux. Dr. Donald Pulver has 20 years of experience using this technique and he teaches hands on workshops at the American College of Allergy Asthma and Immunology (ACAAI) as well as the American Academy of Allergy Asthma and Immunology (AAAAI).
